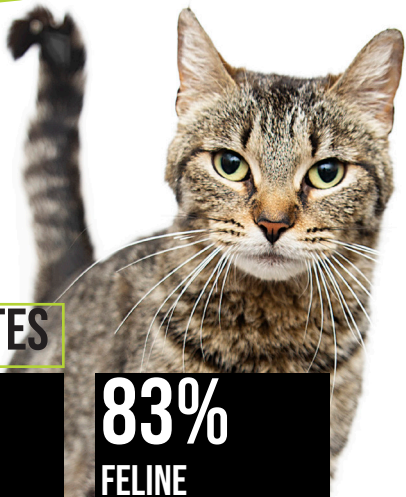

Although 2020 started out to become the best year LHS had ever seen, along came COVID-19 and its many challenges.

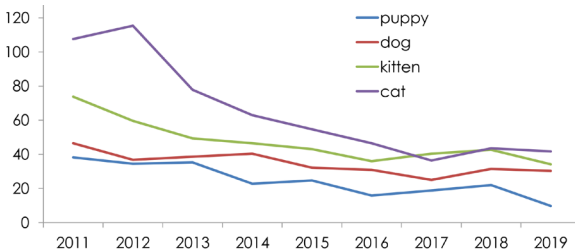

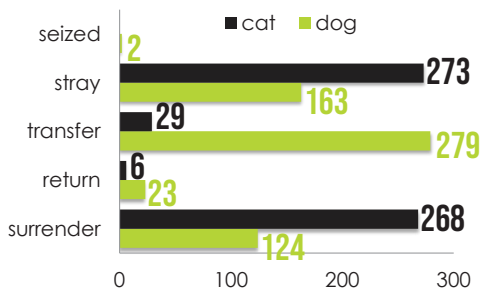

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO FIND A FOREVER HOME?



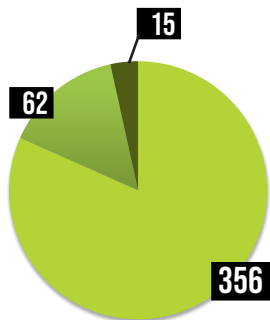
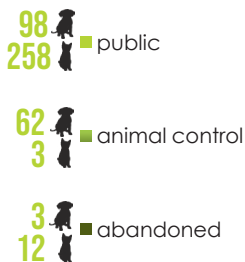

HOW DID PETS ENTER THE SHELTER?

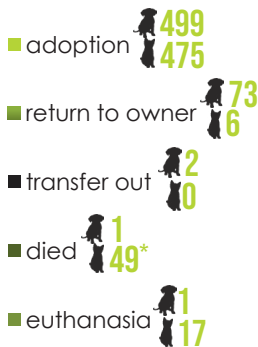
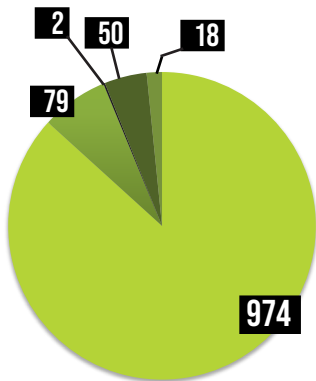
